The winner

Julianne Moore, (born **Julie Anne Smith**; December 3, 1960) is an American-British actress. In year 2015 she won the Golden Globe Award, the Screen Actors Guild Awards and the Oscar as Actress in a leading role for the film "Still Alice".

She also won: Coppa Volpi by the Festival del Cinema in Venice with "Far from Heaven" (2002), the Golden Bear with "The Hours" (2003) and the "Prix d'interpretation feminine" by the Festival de Cinema in Cannes with "Map to the Stars" (2014).
